Each night diners packed into the restaurant and watched Craig compete on the 65 inch TV screen while he was cooking in the kitchen.

Just before the results were announced each night he Facebooked Lived himself and the diners to cheers all round as night by night he cooked up a storm.

That will continue this week.

On finale day on Friday FGH chef and good friend Andy Bickle was on hand to show his support and cheer Craig on.

The judges are joined by guest judge GP, author and presenter Dr Rangan Chatterjee, whose work with the public, including on TV series Doctor in the House, provides life-changing care for families across the country.

Who will win the first coveted spot on the final banquet menu?

At school he was one of two boys in his GCSE Food Studies class and both ironically went on to be amazing chefs.

He trained at Morecambe College before honing his skills at Lakeside, Stoss Hall plus London and the Cotswold before heading to Urswick to take over the General Burgoyne in 2010.

The chef of 24 years then headed to Ulverston in September 2015 and as well as his restaurant he has a popular gin bar and eight guest bedrooms.
